

ATTENTION - CONSTRUCTION CLOSURES at Silver Creek Preserve

Starting Monday, August 24th, the Kilpatrick Bridge will be closed for replacement. This closure will cut off access to the Silver Creek Preserve from the eastern entrance (Kilpatrick Bridge Rd). Please be aware of the following closure details:

- All recreational floating (canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, etc.) on Stalker Creek/Silver Creek through the Preserve will be closed.
- Downstream float tube fishing access from the Kilpatrick Bridge to the lower pond will be closed.
- Float tube fishing from access point FT1 downstream to the Kilpatrick Bridge will be closed.
- Float tube access will be allowed on the Preserve between FT1-FT4. Foot access to FT3 (north side of the creek) will be closed due to a trail closure.
- **IMPORTANT—Starting October 1st, all float tube fishing on the Preserve will close** for dredging operations.
- Closures will remain in place until project completion (estimated timeline—January 2027).

Please use caution and drive slowly when accessing the Preserve from the western entrance (Stalker Creek Rd.).
